"**Come Fly with Me**", and that's just what we did on Sunday, 3rd August at Mittagong Airfield. The day was a "fly-in" for light aircraft and they came from as far away as Newcastle, Orange, Canberra and the South Coast - from ultra-lights to a \$ 3million twin-jet 10-seater passenger aircraft. Also the Russian "Yak" owned by Mark and Sharon Willard and its Chinese replica that gave us an aerobatic display.

We found that the members of the aero-club were so accommodating especially Wayne Boatwright and Mark and Sharon Willard and they showed a genuine interest in our cars.

Eddie Morris is a born-and-bred local and had his ultra-light fuelled up and ready to go. He said to me, "Come and fly with me!" – and that is just what I did. 12 year old Maddison Chalker-Holtz was next and she couldn't keep the smile off her face.

I really didn't know what to expect, but the day was perfect for flying, with hardly a breath of wind. Eddy's plane is powered with a German 2-cylinder upright engine with a pusher prop and I could not believe how well it went. It lifted off so quickly and felt so stable as we flew out over Willow Vale around the outskirts of Mittagong and Renwick and came in for a perfect landing on the old historic strip that was built in the early war years. Thankfully it has been updated many times since. It was an enjoyable trip and I am glad I took up the challenge. I would draw the line at parachuting though – it's too dangerous for old people like me. Come to think of it we didn't have one on in the ultra-light.

We enjoyed a barbecue lunch cooked up by the aero club's members and celebrated Sam's 70th birthday (also Alan Barker's birthday) with a cake supplied by Everil and John Glennon. It was a great day with a good roll up from the Club.

**ACMC** The Modified Vehicle plate is an ongoing discussion. While some are nervous it is hoped it will take some pressure off the historical plates. (Historical plates apply to cars over 35 years).

Rego for motor cycles should become a reality. Rules and guidelines for Street Rods are out.

**Affiliations** (Lester) There are 4 outstanding applications to commence. SLK Driver's Club Inc., Central West Inc., Porsche and Sydney Antique Machinery Club. Hunter California Cruising Club and Chrysler Club wish to come to Shannon's Sydney Motor classic.

**General Business**

*'New Plates' Victorian Scheme..* Victoria is introducing the M plate system. For modified vehicles. Victoria's problem is that there are lots of modified cars on historical plates. Some drivers are not properly registered. There were 10,000 vehicles in 2010 and now 47,000 vehicles transferring off full rego to conditional rego which is a huge financial problem for the govt.

Some other issues –

- latest issues of modified Ford want historical plates
- retractable seatbelts in old cars
- unfinancial members are running risk re being unregistered incl. Green slip
- if RMS makes an error it is not your fault
