

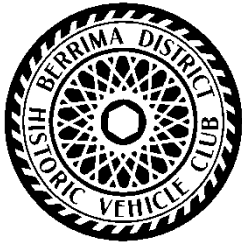

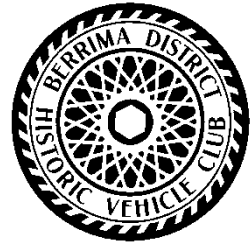

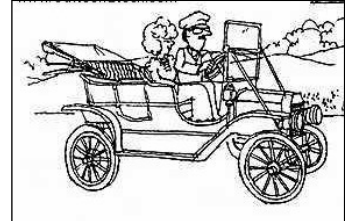
General Business


