There was a strong reaction to the MADMEN story in the October issue, so we have compiled MADMEN II. It pays homage to a time when artists drew cars for print advertisements. It is visual medium no longer used in these days of sharp digital photography and internet connectivity.

We profile Michael Jeanes' 1962 Pontiac Tempest Le Mans convertible and trace its evolution through the Pontiac styling studios with our signature images of the Le Mans prototypes sourced from GM's vaults in Detroit. Thanks to John Kyros at the GM Heritage Center for his research efforts.

Cord and Duesenberg designer Gordon Beuhrig invented the T-Top for his 1949 TASCOCO sports car. We've the story and the images of this unique car and its innovative roof.

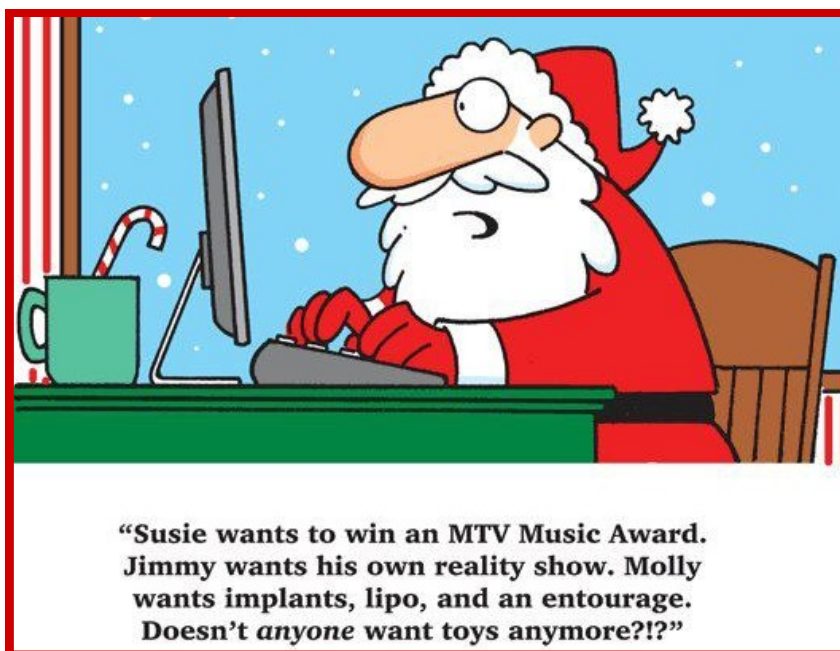
