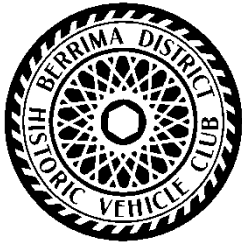

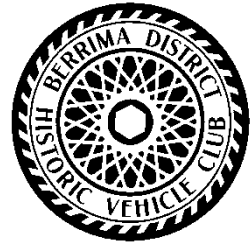

It was also great to see our local MP and the Mayor give us some kind words of encouragement.

Southern Highlands News Monday 11th February, 2013



VEHICLES OF ALL SORTS ROLLED INTO THE HIGHLANDS THE 38TH BERRIMA RALLY ON THE WEEKEND.

Berrima District Historic Vehicle Club hosted the event, with 172 participants in this year's rally more than doubling last year's number of entrants. Vehicle enthusiasts gathered at Wyeera Race Course in Bowral for the rally on Saturday, which was moved to the home of the Bong Bong Picnic Races as part of the Bowral and Moss Vale sesquicentenary celebrations.

Owners of vehicles of all shapes and sizes entered into one of 11 categories, with some vehicles dating back earlier than the 1920s. The rally was open to vehicles of all types, including tractors and horse-drawn carts as well as cars, trucks and motorcycles.

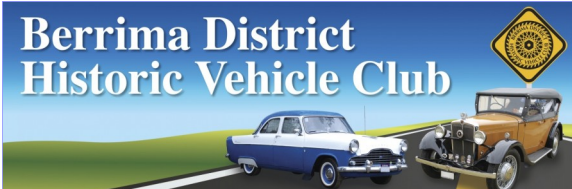
Rally secretary Pauline McFetridge said the turnout on the weekend "went beyond our wildest dreams" with entrants travelling from across NSW and the ACT to participate. Ms McFetridge estimated about 1000 non-participants visited the rally to get a glimpse of the rare machines. "The venue was sensational, local businesses have been very supportive of the event and council has been just fantastic," she said.

Apart from the rally entrants, 120 vehicles arrived at the race course on Saturday to participate in the Show and Shine competition, which Ms McFetridge said was "basically a display for people to come and show off their favourite toy". "It's wonderful because it enables people to talk to other vehicle owners."

The group held a dinner dance on Saturday night where vehicle owners came dressed in clothing typical of the period in which their vehicle was made. "It was a real community-focused night," Ms McFetridge said.

Vehicles set off at 8am yesterday for a 97km drive through the Highlands, stopping at Exeter for morning tea before returning to Bowral for lunch. Ms McFetridge said the highlight of this year's rally was the camaraderie shown by people from all walks of life. Berrima District Historic Vehicle Club President Bill Flegg and Berrima Rally Director Peter Mills were pleased with how the rally went.

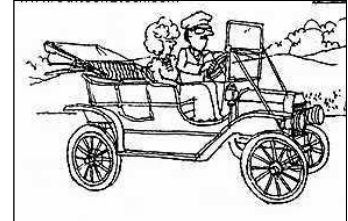


