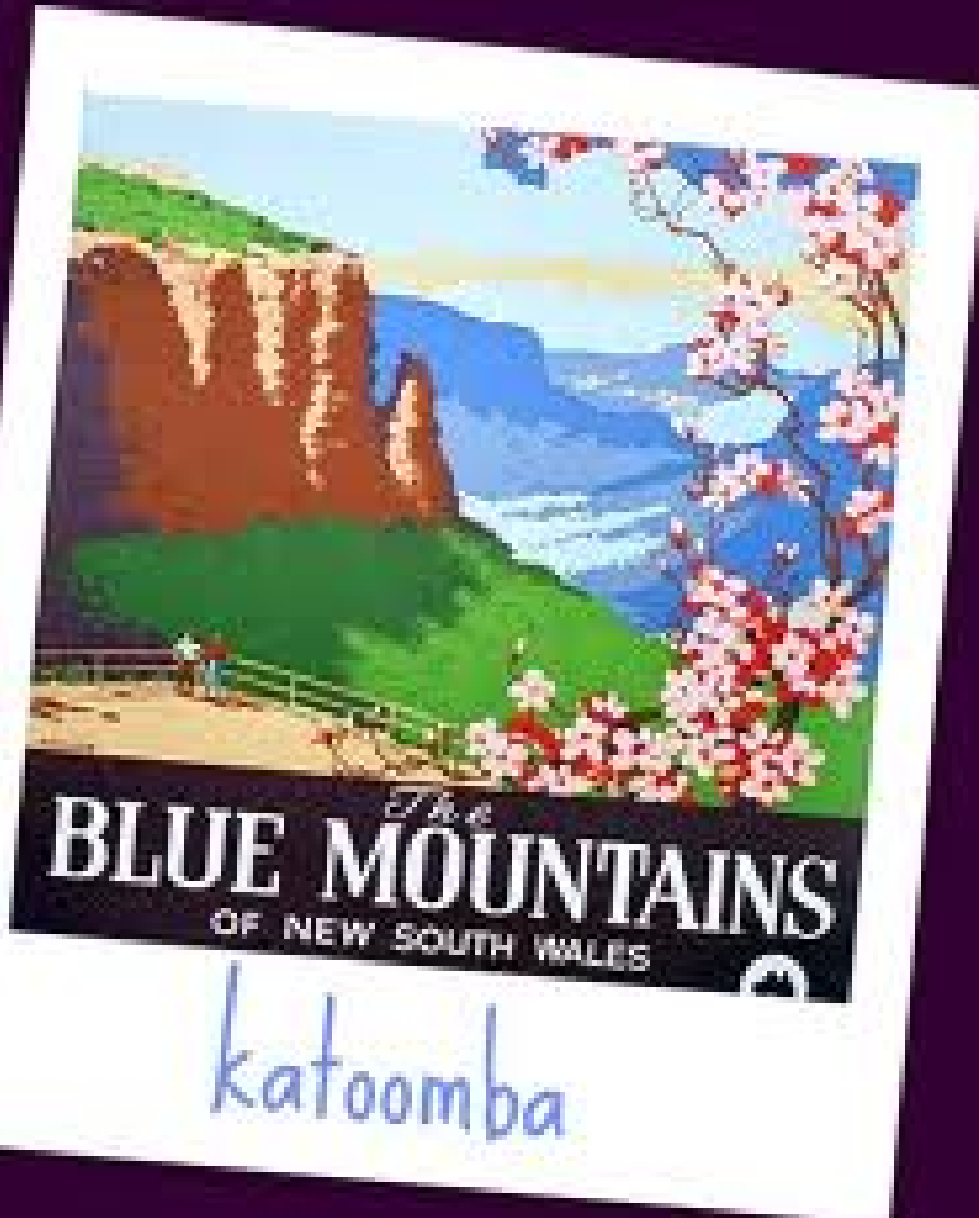

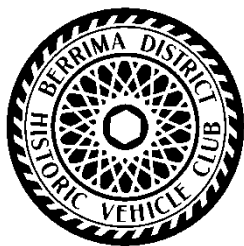

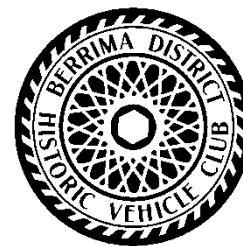

There being no further business the raffle was drawn and the meeting closed at 8.45pm followed by supper (mmm did State of Origin have any influence on the early end – I wonder).

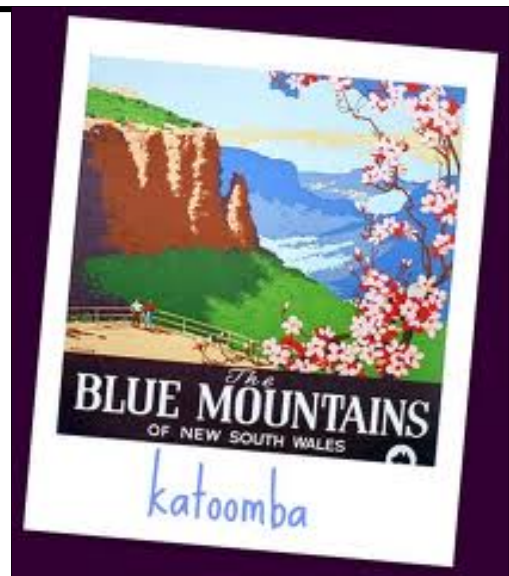

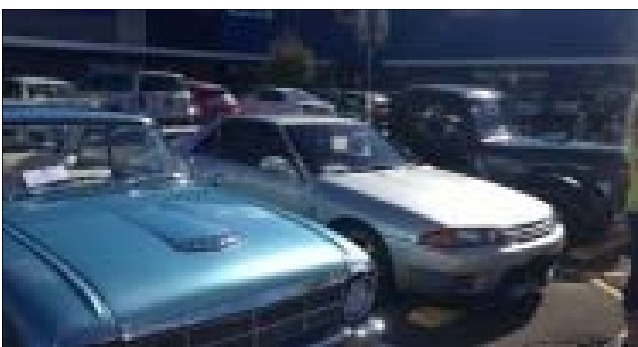
MITTAGONG MARKET PLACE SHOW & SHINE
