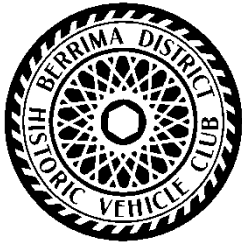

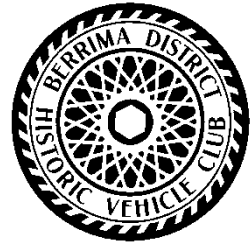

## WINGS OVER ILLAWARRA

The annual Wings Over Illawarra not for profit Airshow took place on 5th May in perfect weather and with large crowds at Illawarra Regional Airport and was a super success.

The show theme was “Celebrating Naval Aviation” with air displays by a Royal Australian Navy Seahawk helicopter (with the Red Berets) and the fascinating Navy Squirrel helicopter precision flying act. A Grumman S2G Tracker and Navy Auster were on static display.

This year is also the 100th year of the Royal Australian Navy and there was as a display of models of significant Australian Navy warships of past days. In the air the crowd favourites included Matt Hall’s two precision aerobatic displays, the Australian Army’s Red Berets precision parachuting team, the Southern Biplanes Stearman routine and of course two displays by perennial favourites the RAAF Roulettes aerobatic formation team who also closed the airshow.

The air display also included an aerobatic display by one of three Hawk fast jets of the Royal Australian Air Force which attended. Also flying were the HARS Catalina, Caribou and C47 plus a P51 Mustang, Jet Provost, Harvard and the Temora Aviation museum with the world’s last air-worthy Gloster Meteor fighter and Hudson Bomber, and a CAC Boomerang. Favourites on the ground included the F111 and the HARS Connie.

Many vintage and veteran vehicle clubs and a stationary engine display also attended adding to the interest for the crowd.

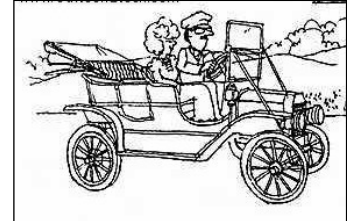
**WHAT IMPORTANT HISTORICAL EVENTS HAPPENED IN AUSTRALIA IN 1973**

- 10 February – Australia's first casino, the Wrest Point Hotel Casino, opens in Hobart
- 28 February – The federal voting age is lowered from 21 to 18. The state of New South Wales had already enacted such a change in 1970.
- 1 June – The first General Dynamics F-111 aircraft is delivered to the Royal Australian Air Force
- 20 October – Sydney Opera House officially opened by Elizabeth II
- The White Australian Policy (established 1901) is officially dismantled
- Vietnam War ends
- The federal voting age is dropped from 21 to 18
- Unionists save the historic "The Rocks" area of Sydney from demolition by introducing "Green Bans"
- Patrick White becomes the first Australian to win the Nobel Prize for Literature & is announced as Australian of the Year
- 1 December – Papua New Guinea is granted self government prior to independence
- 31 December – AC/DC perform their first major gig in Sydney Australia.


