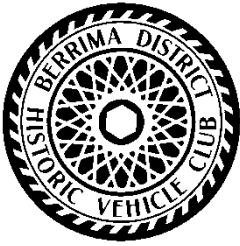

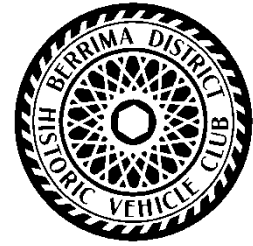

 Oh, no, oh, no, not us, **we got lost on our way**

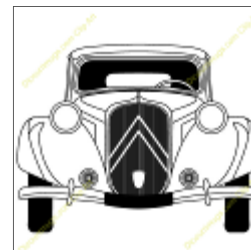
For what is a man, what has he got?
