



OPEN DAY 22 SEPTEMBER, 2013

CAMDEN PARK HOUSE

Rod & I had an enjoyable day at Camden Park House on a beautiful spring Sunday. We joined the Jaguar Drivers Club of Australia to park under the gracious old trees adjacent to the house & gardens.

Camden Park is the large Georgian house built for John and Elizabeth Macarthur in 1835 and is believed to be Australia's oldest private residence occupied by descendants of its founders. The house is two storied stuccoed sandstock brick built on sandstone foundations. It still retains much of its original furniture and fittings and is a wonderful example of the work of colonial architect John Verge.

The large garden which surrounds the house is the largest intact 19th century garden in Australia and contains many rare and exotic species, many of which were collected by John Macarthur's son William (1800-1882) who lived at Camden Park.

The wisteria hedge which borders the eastern verandah was in full bloom and is a magnificent sight. Recent restoration work in the garden has brought back much of the garden's former glory.






